






Horse is just an oversized dog with funny paws, according to Dog. And Dog? Just a tiny baby horse with a weird tail. That's what Horse thinks, anyway.








A big sister, a little brother, an apartment building, and a short journey to bring cookies and soup to a sick neighbor equals a big adventure in this original picture book

The first in a laugh-out-loud middle-grade series about the eternal conflict between cats and robots—and the fur it raises between two siblings who find themselves on opposite sides.




