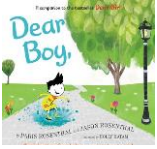

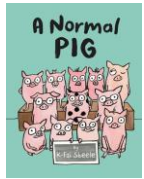

A smart, funny, and honest contemporary novel about a kid who tries to set the record straight when he and his friends from the Special Ed class are suspected of a crime they didn't commit.



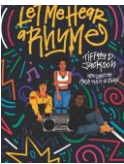
